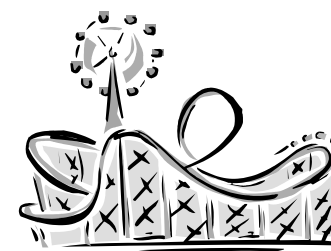
JULY EVENTS
